Chia Seeds Pudding

A nutritious breakfast or snack option that supports weight management thanks to its high fiber and protein content, helping you stay satisfied longer.

Ingredients

½ cup milk of choice (almond, light coconut, or oat milk)

2 tablespoons chia seeds

½ teaspoon sweetener (maple syrup, honey, or sugar)

Pinch of cinnamon powder or small cinnamon stick

Instructions

- Heat the milk until hot.
- Transfer the heated milk to a jar with a lid.
- Add chia seeds, sweetener, and cinnamon to the milk.
- Cover the jar and allow the mixture to cool to room temperature.
- Shake well to combine all ingredients.
- Refrigerate for a few hours, then stir thoroughly to break up any clumps.
- Continue chilling overnight or until the pudding reaches desired consistency.
- Top with your preferred fruits and nuts before serving.

Optional Toppings

- Fresh cherries
- ✓ Blueberries or other berries
- Chopped nuts
- ✓ Any fresh fruit of your choice

Storage and Tips

Prep ahead: Make a batch on weekends and portion into individual containers.

Storage: Keeps well in the refrigerator for up to 5 days.

Consistency adjustment: If the pudding becomes too thick, thin it out with a splash of milk before serving.

asy to fall into the trap of relying on technology, particularly, AI tools to do all the work for you. While AI is an dible resource, overusing it can impact one's ability to think critically and solve problems independently. Think ke using a calculator for every simple math problem—eventually, you might forget how to do basic calculations r head!

rticle aims to quide you on how to use AI tools effectively in your everyday life, without losing your own em-solving skills.


Imagine you're a programmer tasked with writing a code. With AI tools like "ChatGPT" or "Gemini" it's tempting to simply type in a guery and let the Al provide a solution. For instance, you might input: "Write a function to sort an array in Python." The tool quickly spits out the code, and you're done. But what's missing here? Your own logic.

Instead, you can use Al in a more productive way. First, write the code yourself. Then, use the Al tool to optimize it. Ask the tool why certain changes should be made. For example, "Can you suggest improvements for this code, and explain why those changes are necessary?" This allows you to understand why certain methods or techniques are better, expanding your knowledge and improving your problem-solving skills. By using AI to complement your knowledge, you learn new ways to approach problems, rather than just relying on it to do everything for you.

Let's say you're a content writer with brilliant ideas, but you struggle to articulate them professionally. Instead of relying on AI to write your entire article, start by drafting your thoughts in your own words. Once you have a rough idea, you can use AI tools to help polish and rephrase it. For instance, you might input your draft into an AI tool and ask, "Can you rephrase this in a more professional tone?" The AI tool will suggest improvements, making your writing sound more refined. You can then take those suggestions, adjust them further, and add your own flair to make the content truly yours.

In both examples, AI is a helpful assistant, but it's your personal logic and creativity that makes the final product stand out. The key is to use AI as a tool that enhances your work, not as a crutch that replaces your abilities.

By finding the right balance—using AI for optimization and enhancement while still applying your own critical thinking you can avoid the trap of becoming too reliant on it and continue growing your skills.
